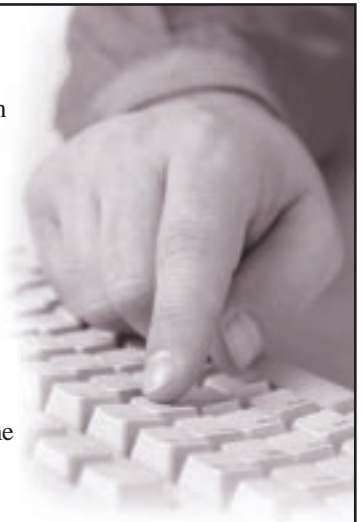
Fire Up Your Online Hotline

And Speaking of Online Convenience...

The American Financial Services Association and the Education Foundation in Washington, D.C. offers these tips for shopping on the Internet:

- Before you make an online purchase, check the Web site for a phone number and mailing address (a street address, not a post office box). If you do not recognize the name of the company, call the number to confirm that the business does exist.
- Check the Web site for the term "SSL," which stands for secure socket layer and indicates that the site uses security measures to keep others from finding out your credit card account number.
- After making a purchase, print out the Web page on which the confirmation appears. If it shows an order confirmation number, it can serve as a receipt.
- Check your credit card statement to ensure that charges for Internet purchases were posted accurately. Call the credit card company immediately if they were not.
- If you do not receive your merchandise within 30 days, but the charges has been posted to your credit card, contact the online seller for an explanation. If you get no satisfaction, then call the credit card company.
